-Representation index= Aim for something close to one

- -Use local norms (not national norms)
- -Cluster Grouping Question
 - -how do you envision every child growing in a heterogeneous class?
 - -is it something that is reasonable or could really happen?
 - -should still have diversity in every classroom
- -if can't group all in one class- possible flexible grouping during specific subject areas as needed
